

J) Phys. Ed Contract

Dear Parents and student,

The following guidelines must be fully understood and accepted by both yourself and your parents.

1. Students are expected to participate positively in ALL PE/HPC activities which occur within and outside of the school setting. This positive attitude will have a direct bearing on the level of student achievement and final evaluation (Outcomes C & D / Participation)
2. Since many of the activities take place outside of the school and because students represent not only themselves, but the teachers and St. Albert Catholic High as well, inappropriate behavior will NOT be tolerated. Abuse of equipment, derogatory language or actions, and general acts of irresponsibility will result in an immediate loss of 3%. Students may be removed from the immediate activity and in severe cases, may be removed from the class.
3. Students are expected to attend ALL field trips in and out of the city. These include activities that take place outside of regular class times, including prior to first block, lunchtime or after school, as required. **AT NO TIME is a student allowed to drive to an outside school activity. This is a GSACRD board policy – all transportation will be administered / coordinated by SACHS.**
4. **LEADERSHIP / SERVICE HOURS** component: Service is required by each student to assist in the intramural and interscholastic athletic programs of the school (drama, S.U.-dances etc.). Many of these activities are during the school day! Failure to complete a portion of the leadership component may result in a failing final grade. **(-2% for each incomplete hour with a maximum of 10% taken from the final grade)**
5. **Activities:** The HPC10/PE20 program offers students the opportunity to explore activities not available at other levels. These mandatory activities are primarily out of school and unfortunately are not free. Students were made aware of this prior to registration for the course last spring. A fee of \$80.00 is required and can be made payable to St. Albert Catholic High.

This cost includes:

- t-shirt;
- booked activities such as;
 - i. introduction to; rock climbing (Vertically Inclined), bowling, x-country skiing, golf and driving range, Martial Arts class, PHAT training, laser tag, mini-golf, billiards, use of Servus Centre (swimming) and guest instructors.

Due to booking arrangements, activities and costs associated with them have been priced out based on all student participation. Therefore, unless staff is made aware well in advance, should a student not be able to participate in an activity **there will be no refund.**
